Bound by Route One, Scudders Mill Road, Campus Road and Plainsboro Road/Millstone River, the hospital is accessible by various bus routes and senior transportation services.

Public Transportation

This free service is only available in parts of Monroe Township. Pickup is on weekdays at 8:30 a.m. and the return shuttle leaves the hospital at noon. For more information, call **609.853.6500** and press 0 to speak with an operator.

Transportation from Princeton

If you live within a short distance of the previous hospital campus at 253 Witherspoon Street and you have no means of transportation to Plainsboro, but you have an appointment at the Bristol-Myers Squibb Community Health Center or the Medical Arts Pavilion, or need non-emergency care at the PMC campus, the hospital will provide free door-to-door transportation. This is available Monday through Friday, from 7:30 a.m. to 6 p.m.

To see if you qualify or to schedule a ride, call **609.853.6200** on weekdays from 8 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Please call at least 24 hours in advance and schedule a pickup time at least 30 minutes prior to your appointment. This service is intended for non-emergencies only. Anyone experiencing a medical emergency should call 9-1-1.
